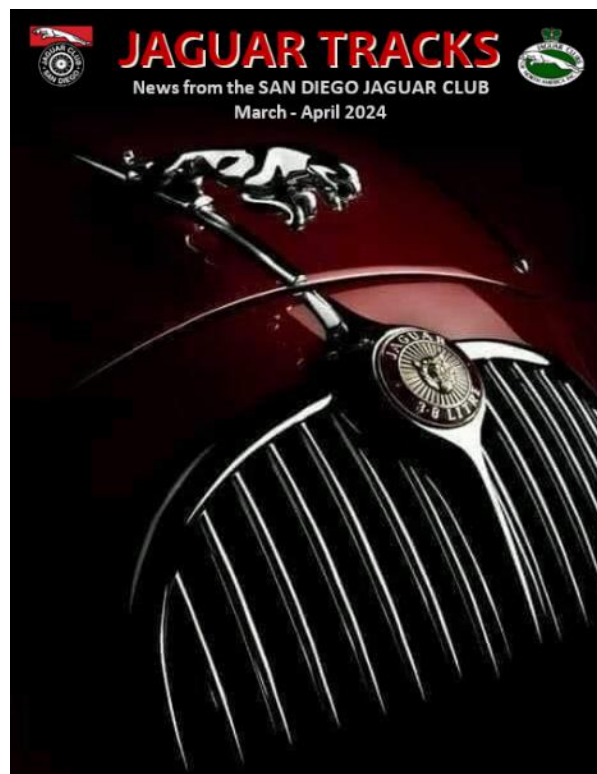

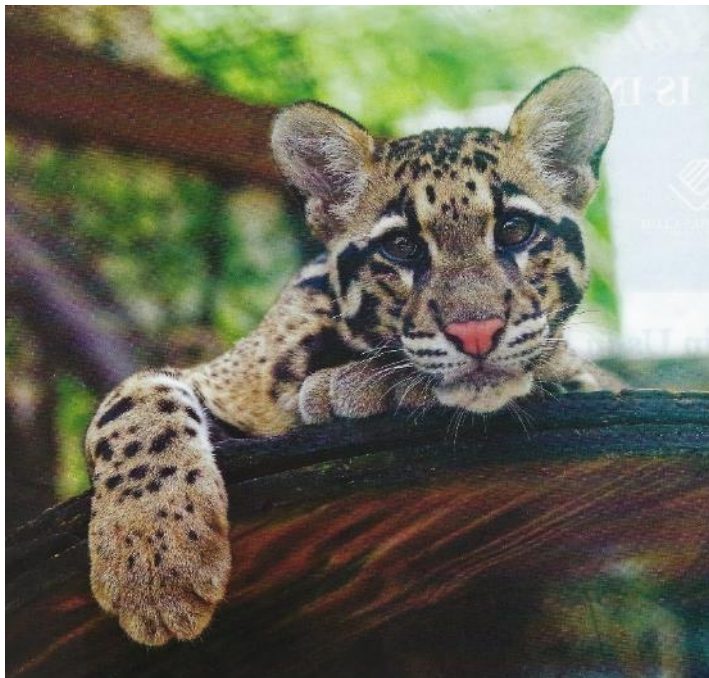

The Palomar Observatory is a popular destination in Southern California and receives tens of thousands of visitors from around the world. Most visitors come to see the famous 200-inch Hale Telescope, which for decades was the largest effective telescope in operation. Whether you are an astronomy, history, or engineering enthusiast, or simply curious about the observatory, you will enjoy visiting the Telescope Dome, Visitors Center, Gift Shop and Museum. During March, all tours are self-guided using an audio guide via your smart phone. After visiting the Observatory, we will enjoy a picnic lunch on the beautiful grounds. Special restrictions regarding pets and children: No children under 5 and no pets are allowed on tours, except service dogs are welcome. Mobility restrictions: Wheelchairs cannot access the telescope – the Dome is a moderate distance from the parking lot. There is a 1,050 foot slightly uphill, paved walking path that connects the Dome to the parking lot. The Dome requires climbing 70 steps. Mobility impaired visitors will receive special instructions at the Gift Shop. Climate: The interior of the Hale Telescope is kept at nighttime temperatures for an elevator of 5,598 feet and temperatures are often in the 30's and 40's, dress according. There is a possibility of snow in March, in that case the Drive will be re-scheduled, most likely for the following weekend weather permitting.

# Notes from the Concours Judge's Tent

March - April 2024

Get ready for 2024 Concours Season! We have four JCNA Concours d'Elegance events planned for the region. Additionally, the International Jaguar Festival is in Arizona, which is relatively local for the serious enthusiast.

- June 1st SW Regional Concours - Huntington Beach Central Park
- June 2nd LA Club Concours - Huntington Beach Central Park
- July 13th SDJC 60th Concours d'Elegance - Spanish Landing Park
- September 28th International Jaguar Festival Concours - Twin Arrows Casino Resort - Flagstaff, AZ
- October 5th Inland Empire Jaguar Club Concours d'Elegance - Idyllwild Inn

There has been quite a bit of activity behind the scenes to get ready for the new season: Since late December we have been busy proofreading the 2024 JCNA Concours Rule Book. Steve Kennedy - the JCNA Rule Book editor does an amazing job! The new rule book has 162 replacement pages, but by far the majority are administrative updates only. There are no substantive changes for Judges or entrants. Most of the "real" changes are associated with organizing the Concours and timescales for the Chief Judge to update Judge's training records and certification status. Note that the Club has several hard copies of the rule book for study, and for use at the Concours events. (I'm leaning forwards - they're ordered and should be available by mid-March.)

Formal, annual Judges' refresher training is required each year by JCNA to recertify Judges for the current concours year. It includes a presentation, a review of the more important aspects of the JCNA Concours Rule Book, and discussions of the Rule Book changes for 2024. The 2024 Judges' Test will be available also. Everyone is welcome to attend. This is an excellent way for Judges and Entrants to learn more about JCNA Concours Rules. **This year's training will be virtual via Zoom on April 6<sup>th</sup>.** This will be similar to last year's event and will be open to all SW regional clubs. The event is open on the website - please register for zoom details. If the 6th doesn't work for you, please reach out and we can schedule an alternative. Did you know the rule book training used by JCNA for this and all events was developed over the years by prior SDJC Chief Judges? To continue the tradition, I have updated the training material for this year. Last year we had an on-line test (no paper) which worked really well. Matt Allen - our webmaster - developed that, and for this year the same format will be available for the whole of JCNA!

**On April 20th we will have "Hands On" Judges Training at Nedra's home.** Please register early so we can be prepared! This is a fun event to practice judging with official score sheets, JCNA Concours Rule Books and JCNA Judge's Guides. This is ideal for Apprentices and experienced Judges alike to brush up on the Concours judging processes. The event objectives are to practice without time limit on a couple of cars, and then "graduate" with a judging event in the regulation 15 minutes. By the way - this is also a great opportunity to bring your own Jaguar for some non-competitive insight, or get opinions on must-fix items.

We are continually looking for a few good women and men to become new Concours Judges. The process to become a judge is simple and there's never been a better time with all the training coming up! Note that judges can focus on models they have the most familiarity.

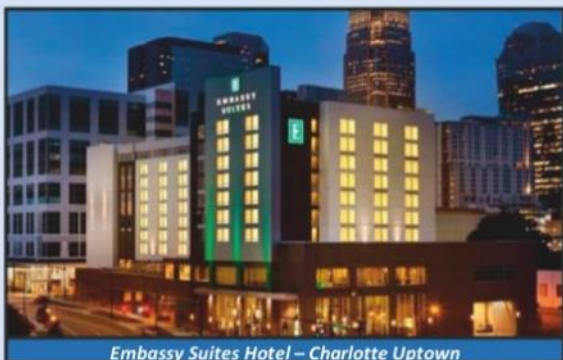

## 2024 JCNA Annual General Meeting March 14-17 Charlotte, North Carolina

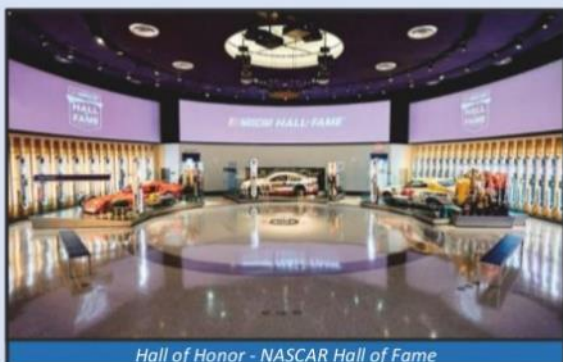

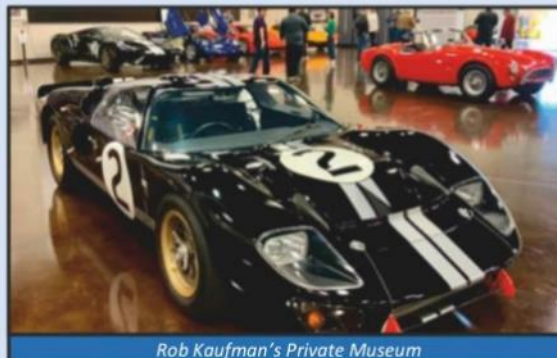

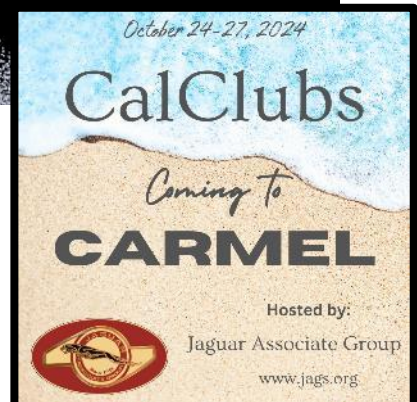

# SDJC Board of Directors Meeting Minutes

James Waite  
January 10, 2024

## Call to Order / Attendance:

The Meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm via Zoom Video Conference by the Club President.

The officers present were Dan Jensen, President; Nedra Rummell, 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President Membership; Dave Allen, Treasurer & Chief Judge; James Waite, Secretary; Chuck Leuthen, Newsletter Editor; Matt Allen, Webmaster; Al Steele, Director; Tim Bennett, Director; Dave Putnam, Director & British Car Club Council Representative; Jim Hallameyer, Dealer Representative; and Marie Allen, Historian.

## Board Reports:

- **Secretary's Report:** James reported that the Minutes of the November 8, 2023 meeting were approved electronically. The Minutes were forwarded to Chuck for inclusion in the newsletter.
  
- **Treasurer's Report:** Dave A. reported the following:
  - For December, the activities include income of \$360.00 for classified ads. Expenses for December were \$288.69, comprising Bank fees (\$25.19), JCNA Dues paid on behalf of members (\$100.00), Monthly storage locker fee (\$158.00), and the monthly payment for the domain name email accounts (\$5.50). Overall, we had a net income of \$71.31 for the month. For January, the activity includes \$5,060.00 for 2024 membership dues, of which a significant portion will be paid to JCNA. Club finances remain healthy.
  - Dave researched Money Market accounts versus a CD. He found a CD is the best option.
  - Dave provided the 2023 Annual Summary. Per Section 5.06.4 of the by-laws, "*A summary sheet of all SDJC income, expenditures, and account balances shall be provided to any Member on request and shall be published on the SDJC website secure Club Member's Page.*" Per Section 8.03, "*The Newsletter Editor shall place a notice in the Club's electronic newsletter, within the time permitted by law, stating that an Annual Financial Report is available by request.*"
  
- **Activities Report: 1<sup>st</sup> VP, Activities Nedra Rummell –**
  - As to the Meet and Drive to Welcome 2024 to the Windmill Food Market in Carlsbad, CA set for January 13 – As of today, we have 21 cars and 33 attendees with hopes of more.
  - On Saturday, February 12, Dan Jensen suggested visiting The Detailing Pros in Huntington Beach, CA. The Detailing Pros are the premier auto detailing specialists of Orange County, CA with over 40 years of experience in expert auto care. Nedra is assisting Dan with this activity. She contacted the company and is waiting for a reply. Nedra will report back.
  - For the balance of the 2024 calendar, last year there were numerous events suggested. Nedra will put together a concise list to send to the board for discussion. Also, Nedra will look into some pop-up events.
  
- **Membership Report – 2<sup>nd</sup> VP, Membership:** Nedra reported the following:

- The new member listing, the roster, the SDJC Membership Directory, and the SDJC Ownership Directory will be updated and forwarded to the Webmaster.
- Nedra will mail letters and call those who have not renewed; renew the roster and make payment to JCNA by January 20; continue to send late renewals to JCNA as they are received; review payments for 15-month dues either credit or refund overpayment. As a reminder, new members joining are paying \$87.50 for 15 months of dues from October 1, 2023, through December 31, 2024.
- **Jaguar Tracks Newsletter Report:** Chuck reported that he is working on the next issue. Also, he suggested sending out an e-blast for the British Invasion Car Show in Dana Point, CA on March 3.

## February 14, 2024

### **Call to Order / Attendance:**

The Meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm via Zoom Video Conference by the Club President.

The officers present were Dan Jensen, President; Nedra Rummell, 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President Membership; Dave Allen, Treasurer & Chief Judge; James Waite, Secretary; Chuck Leuthen, Newsletter Editor; Matt Allen, Webmaster; Al Steele, Director; Tim Bennett, Director; Dave Putnam, Director & British Car Club Council Representative; Jim Hallameyer, Dealer Representative; and Marie Allen, Historian.

### **Board Reports:**

- **Secretary's Report:** James reported that the Minutes of the January 10, 2024 meeting were approved electronically. The Minutes were forwarded to Chuck for inclusion in the newsletter.
- **Treasurer's Report:** Dave A. reported the following:
  - For January, the activities include income of \$10,801.50 comprising \$10,170.00 received for club dues, \$401.50 for advertising, and \$230.00 for the Mission tour. Expenses for January were \$1,045.63 comprising AGM delegate fees (\$510.00), Bank fees (\$99.86), JCNA dues (\$90.00), online processing fee to the Port Authority for the 2024 Concours (\$35.00), office supplies (\$147.27), monthly storage facility fees (\$158.00), and the monthly domain name email accounts fee (\$5.50). Overall, we had a net income of \$9,755.87 for the month. This excess income is due to the time phasing of dues received, and corresponding payments to JCNA being processed. February sneak peek: \$5,000+ paid to JCNA on behalf of our members. A new ad was received, and the Mission tour admission payments and expenses have been processed. Club finances remain healthy.
  - All automatic payments have been transferred from PayPal to Bank of America. The PayPal account is now closed, and the balance transferred to the Bank of America checking account.

- As to a CD or Money Market account: Research last year showed FDIC-insured money market accounts were available only for individuals, and not "organizations." He has an appointment with Bank of America to open a CD account. He asked for approval to deposit \$20,000 into a one-year CD account paying about 4.5%. A Motion to allow the Treasurer to open a one-year \$20,000 CD account at Bank of America was submitted by Dave A., seconded by Chuck, and approved unanimously.
- Dave asked whether the club wants to continue to support the Coventry Foundation at the Club Affiliate level which is \$250.00 annually. [<https://coventryfoundation.org/#home>]. A Motion to continue to support the Coventry Foundation at the Club Affiliate level was submitted by Dave A., seconded by Nedra, and approved unanimously.
- **Activities Report: 1<sup>st</sup> VP, Activities Nedra Rummell –**
  - As to the Meet and Drive to Welcome 2024 to the Windmill Food Market in Carlsbad, CA held on January 13 – Nedra reported that a recap of this event will be sent to Chuck shortly.
  - As to the Drive, Picnic, & Tour of the Mission San Luis Rey Tour held on February, 10 – Nedra reported that it was a successful event with fifty-three attendees and forty-three taking the tour.
  - For March, Nedra is organizing a Drive to and Picnic at the Palomar Observatory. The date is TBD based on the weather. This will be a no-cost event. There is a self-guided tour available. A flyer and event email will be forthcoming.
  - Other SDJC events for 2024:

  - As to the Holiday Party – Dan/Nedra/Rudy Hradecky – Nedra offered a big thank you to Rudy Hradecky for taking the lead on finding a location for the 2024 Holiday Party. Nedra reported that after an exhaustive search to find a venue that meets our budget, the proposed date and location of the party is December 7 at The Bay Club Hotel and Marina on Shelter Island Drive (adjacent to the Silvergate Yacht Club). Dan Jensen, Rudy, and Nedra discussed the possibility of using this venue if we modified the parameters of the Holiday party to meet the venue's limitations. As such, the event room has a limit of 65 attendees; we will not have a dance floor, but guests may dance on a covered heated patio; the dinner will be plated; and Diah Avery and Nedra will be in charge of leading a room-decorating committee. For the Board’s review, Nedra provided an estimate of charges including food options, room rental, and bar room/bartender rental. Dan suggested we supplement the cost for our members. The board discussed the venue, meal options and their associated costs, the cost of decorations, the amount of any potential supplement, and the total net cost of the event. If the club supplements \$20 for each member, the total Club cost would be about \$1,300. All other expenses would be covered by the meal cost and raffle funds. A motion was submitted by Nedra that we hold the SDJC Holiday Party on December 7 at The Bay Club Hotel and Marina, with two meal options, and that the club will provide a \$20 per member supplement. The motion was seconded by Dave A. and passed unanimously.

- **Membership Report – 2<sup>nd</sup> VP, Membership:** Nedra reported the following:
  - We had no new members since our last meeting. We had two late renewals. Our current membership is 128 and 200 members as compared to 121 memberships and 197 members in February 2023. As to the non-renewing members, twenty-one memberships have not been renewed without comment. A final snail mail letter will be sent to them informing them their membership is cancelled but they will be given a last opportunity to renew. This usually results in at least two renewals. Five memberships informed me they would not be renewing. Three members passed in 2023. The renewal sheets and each member's profile were reviewed. Any changes were updated on the Roster and Directories for 2024. An updated JCNA Roster sheet was submitted on January 29 for processing. The SDJC Membership Directory & SDJC Ownership Directory are being updated and will be sent to Matt within the next few days.
- **Jaguar Tracks Newsletter Report:** Chuck – Chuck reported that he is working on the next issue of the newsletter. If any member wishes to submit an article, please contact Chuck.
- **Webmaster Report:** Matt reported that he added flyers to the website for the Mission San Luis Rey tour and the JOCLA tour of the Southern California Railroad Museum; scheduled eblasts for both of these events, updated the classified section; updated the photographs; and will host the Zoom meeting. He also reported that we are currently using 81% of our Wildapricot paid online storage space and may need additional storage. Unfortunately, we cannot purchase additional storage. Matt will look into the various options including archiving certain portions of the material.

#### **Functional Chair Reports:**

- **Advertising Sales in Jaguar Tracks** – Dan – Nothing to report.
- **Auto Museum** – Terry – No report.
- **San Diego British Car Club Council (SDLC)** – Dave reported that the 2024 SDBCCC Rolling British Car Day rally will be held on April 14, and will end at the Bates Nut Farm in Valley Center, CA. Further, the 2024 SDBCCC Car Day show will be held on October 6, at Tidelands Park, Coronado, CA.
- **Concours Chair** – No report as this position is open.
- **Property Manager** – Dave A. – Dave A. reported that he and several volunteers went through the storage locker. They removed surplus items including wooden stakes, old signs, a Perspex podium, a chrome clothes rack, expired first aid items, a sign support, two flags and a heavy support, wine glasses, and champagne flutes. The items remaining are three 8ft tables, three 6ft tables, eight folding chairs, four large canopies, a 2023 through 2024 Concours Anniversary banner, a 25' x 4' SDJC banner, SDJC branded table covers, SDJC branded aluminum signs, six large cones, 20 small cones, event staff t-shirts, parking crew vests, hospitality tote box, ballot box for best in show, kitty litter for oil drip clean-up, four boxes of concours trophies, Chief judge supplies, rally signage and flags, ice cream social items, five walkie-talkies and six chargers, a projector, an old sound system and a King insurance banner. They also removed the *Jaguar Tracks* hard copies for scanning, and other pictures/memorabilia. The memorabilia items that have not sold from the past three outings will be donated to the Coventry Foundation or charity. The website store has been updated to reflect the remaining items.
  - The Tuscher Trophy needs repair as one of the figure's hands is missing. Dave asked if he should get estimates for repair or keep it as-is until we understand the future of the dealership display. We agreed to wait and will discuss this issue at a later date to be determined.

The judge's test will be online this year following the same format that Matt set up for the Southwest Regional Training. He updated the judges training course with the 2024 rules updates which is now the JCNA standard guide and will be available on the JCNA website.
